This lecture explains and argues that the fact that these international environmental principles are set out in texts of varying status, e.g. policy or soft law documents, does not deprive them of normative effect. Indeed, by being recognized in several provisions with normative effect, the prevention, polluter pays, and precautionary principles have specific normative effect rather than being mere regulatory ideals. Furthermore, the fact that international environmental principles are increasingly interpreted in light of specific human rights provisions typifies the post-modern international law in that they are akin to norms whose content is somewhat vague and may lend themselves to a wide range of legal applications.
